Canonisations: Pope Leo XIV will canonise two inspirational young people on 7 September in Rome: Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati who died in 1925 aged 24 and Blessed Carlo Acutis who died in 2006 aged 15. Pier Giorgio was a young Catholic man involved in social justice and politics as member of Catholic Action, served the poor of Turin through the Society of St Vincent de Paul and enjoyed climbing mountains. Carlo, with a deep love for Jesus in the Eucharist and its sensitive to the poor and homeless, was also interested in sports and computers, the internet. He was born and baptised in London before the family returned to Italy. We ask our new saints to pray for us and to inspire us in our friendship with Jesus..
